TRAVEL TOURNAMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

This document serves as a guideline for all players, coaches, and parents in establishing the various roles and responsibilities each has in relation to Capital City VBC travel tournaments which require overnight accommodations.

COACH RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coach and supervise players at the established playing site.
- Communicate to all team players and parents information relating to playing sites, provide maps for playing sites, and daily playing schedules, as well as “in-room/lights out” times for players.
- Provide players and parents with coach’s room number as well as contact information (cell phone, etc.)
- Establish with all team members timelines for departure from hotel (if traveling via caravan) and playing site arrival.
- Be sure all players have transportation to playing site.
- Do not leave playing site until all players have transportation for return to hotel, airport, or home.

Not Responsible For:

- Providing 24 hour care and supervision of players.
- Planning “off” time activities for the players.
- Completing bed checks at various hours of the evening.

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review and adhere to ALL rules established in the CCVBC Tournament and Travel Rules Policy.
- Understand that participation in the Capital City VBC is a privilege that can and will be withdrawn by either the club or your parents if you fail to adhere to these established rules.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide necessary transportation for your own daughter to the playing site, airport, or hotel, or make arrangements for such.
- If possible, attend travel tournaments to assist with the security, safety, and welfare of your daughter and other team members.
- If in attendance, assist with transportation as necessary.
- If in attendance, provide oversight and supervision of team members during non-playing time.
- If in attendance, work with other parents and team coach to coordinate “off” time activities.
- Support ALL team members.
- Be respectful of ALL players, parents, coaches, tournament officials and staff, including kids who are officiating our matches.
- Communicate appropriately with coach if questions or problems arise.
